**S.B. 867--REMEDICATION COURSES**

Dear Superintendent:

Senate Bill 867 was signed by the Governor May 5, 2009, and relates to remediation courses that may be provided by technology center schools. Senate Bill 867 became effective immediately upon approval May 5, 2009.

**Section 1 amends 70 O.S. § 1210.523(C) to read:**

*“Notwithstanding any other provision of law, students who do not attain at least a satisfactory score on any end-of-instruction test shall be provided remediation and the opportunity to retake the test until at least a satisfactory score is attained on the tests of Algebra I, English II and two of the tests required in paragraph 3 of subsection A of this section or an approved alternate test. Technology center schools shall be authorized to provide intervention and remediation in Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, English II, English III, United States History, and Biology I to students enrolled in technology center schools, with the approval of the independent school district board.”*

The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education is authorized to provide intervention and remediation for end-of-instruction tests to students enrolled in technology center schools, with the approval of the independent school district board.
